Just Wanna Play Ball Park Rules for Kingman, AZ

The following guidelines must be adhered to at Kingman, AZ Parks, as required by the Kingman Parks Department. We are excited to be playing, and in order for us to continue to play, the following **MUST** be done. Thank you and I appreciate your cooperation.

1. Alcohol is not allowed anywhere in the park, including parking lots. It is the responsibility of each team to assure no one from their team is drinking. Coolers will be subject to search by tournament and park staff. Anyone bringing alcohol into any city park or the grounds of any park/field being used will be subject to ejection, as will the head coach/manager of any offending team.
2. As a COVID-19 precaution, the dugouts will not be allowed to be used as normal at City of Kingman Parks. Players are to put their bags behind the dugouts. Bats can be put in the dugout. The only people allowed in the dugout are: one coach and the "in the hole" hitter. Of course, players can go through the dugouts on the way to the field. (Suggestion: bring folding chairs for players to be used outside dugouts.)

Adhering to these rules is crucial to a successful and problem-free tournament.
